Under his technical leadership, it has grown into the world's leading application framework supplier, by the company's description. Dahan was a key member of the team leading the successful design and deployment of the integrated apps and widget experience for Liberty Global's Horizon TV multiple-platform TV everywhere product. Most recently, he led the development of the first RDK App Emulator, developed in cooperation with RDK Management, which has tested and certified more than 250 applications as ready for deployment on RDK-based devices. A 17-year software development veteran who taught himself computer programming in BASIC at age 8, Dahan started his career as a software developer for financial-services provider Rabobank ICT, where he was responsible for developing the architecture and back-end technology for the Rabobank website. He was also responsible for multiple Rabobank projects as a consultant. Metrological offers the Metrological Application Framework, a cloud-based application platform designed for any connected device. Its customers include Tier 1 cable companies and telcos reaching more than 20 million households. Dahan attended St. Lauren's College in The Netherlands. He is a published author and presenter, specializing in application platforms, software development and media streaming.
